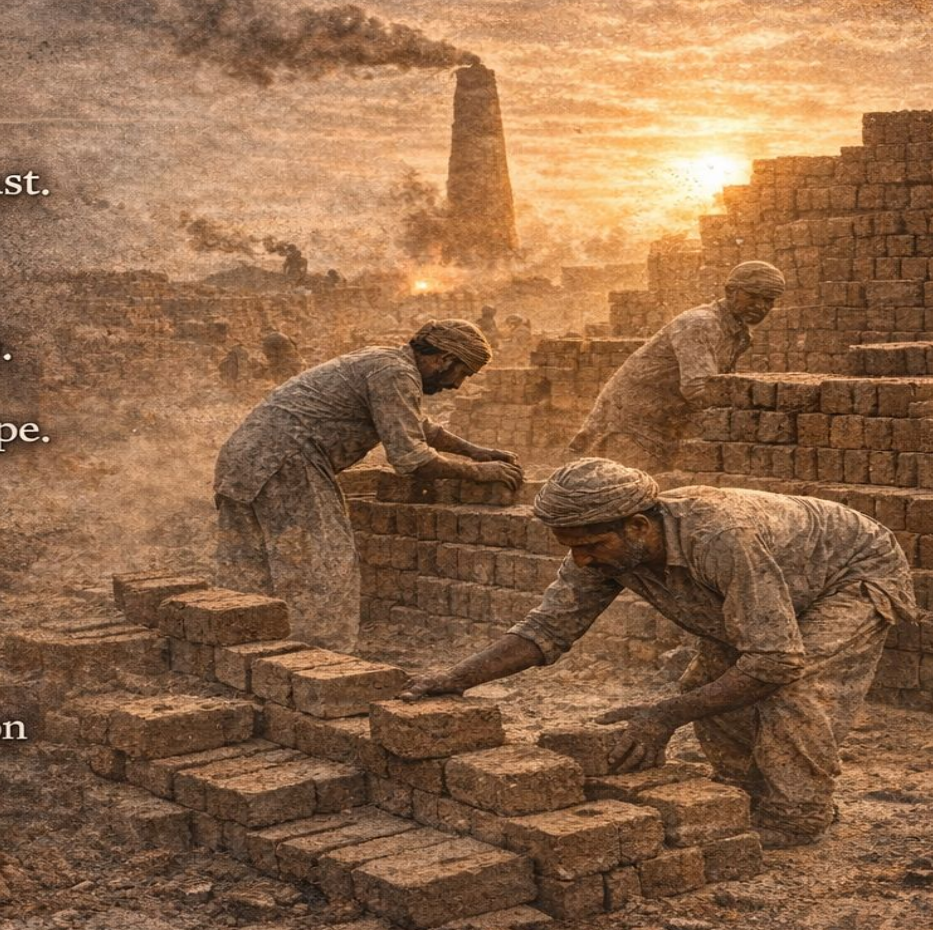
The Challenge

The Daily Reality

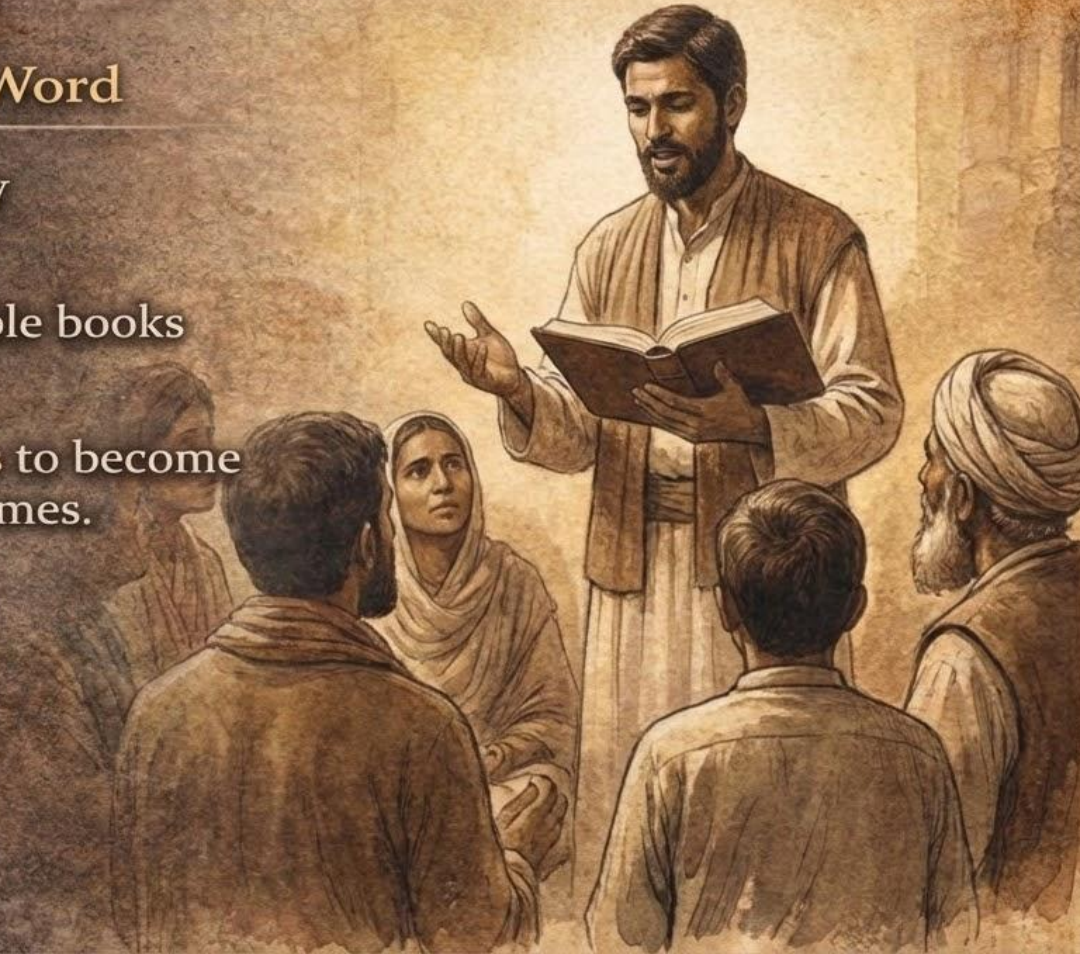
This is one of the most severe cycles of economic bondage and social marginalization affecting vulnerable communities today.

Changing Lives with the Word

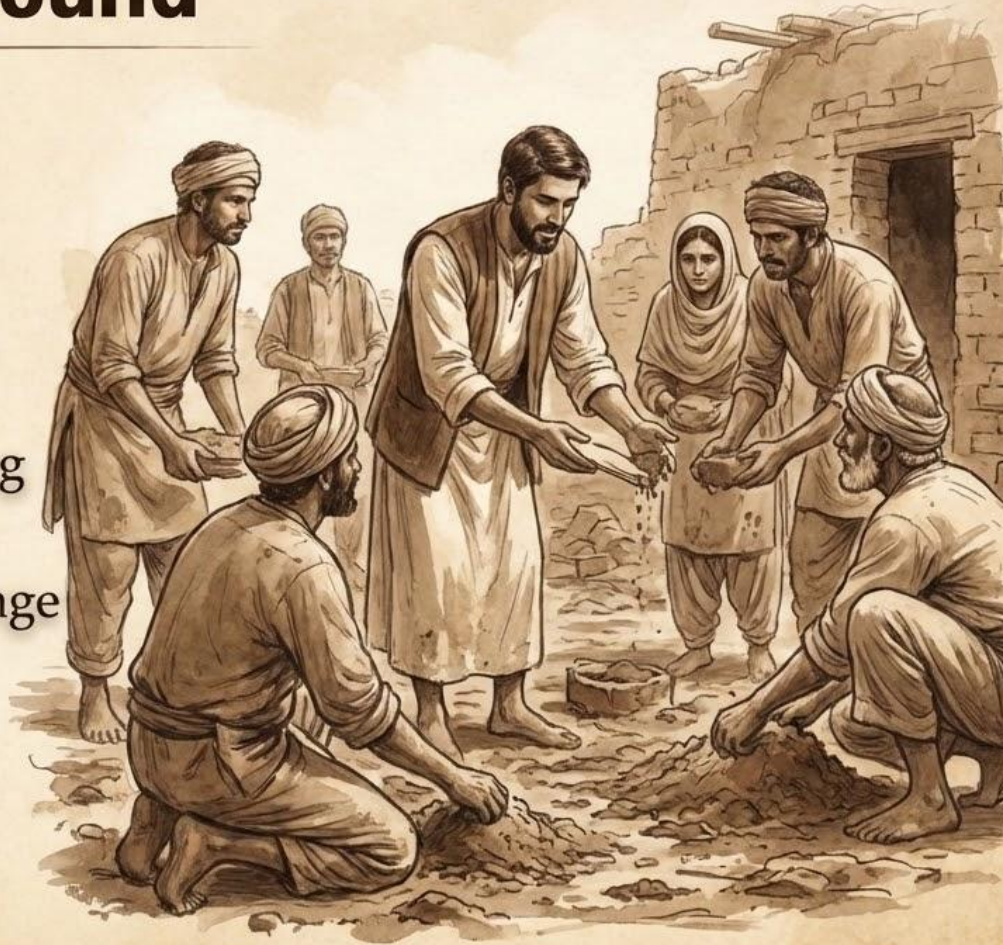
- ☼ Teaching the Word of God orally (speaking to their hearts).
